

**Dear Resident/Business Owner,**

The Great Birmingham Run is returning to the city on **Sunday May 5th 2024** with a great city centre course that showcases the best of Birmingham. Around 12,500 runners will tackle either the Half Marathon or 10K distance with Junior and Mini options for younger runners. The event is being organised by The Great Run Company in conjunction with Birmingham City Council. The aim is to inspire more people to get active more regularly and many runners will be raising money for local and national charities.

Runners will start on Broad Street, adjacent to the iconic Centenary Square before taking on either half marathon or 10k distance before finishing in Smithfield. The route itself will visit parts of the city such as the Jewellery Quarter and West Side before the half marathon course heads south towards Selly Park via Pershore Road, returning through Cannon Hill Park and Edgbaston Cricket Ground and into the finish. The course map and affected roads are detailed in this leaflet but please see [greatrun.org/Birmingham](http://greatrun.org/Birmingham) for further details.

Before and during the run, it will be necessary to implement road closures along the route from 05:00. These have been agreed with Birmingham City Council and will be implemented in phases (closures between 05:00 – 09:00 and re-openings between 12:30 and 16:00).

Times are approximate and the road closures will NOT affect the access of emergency vehicles or pedestrian access. Reopening of roads will be done in a structured manner. Following the last runners, event infrastructure will need to be removed and roads cleansed before the roads can be reopened.

We understand that the road closures will cause some inconvenience. Please plan journeys in advance and allow for additional time as the road network will be busy. Where possible, it would be appreciated if cars can be parked on driveways or on side streets. We will have an uplift system in place on event day to relocate vehicles left on the route. Vehicles removed may be subject to a penalty charge notice so please remove vehicles before closures come into effect.

The Great Birmingham Run will endeavour to minimise disruption to the road network and ensure roads are returned to normal traffic conditions in a timely fashion.
